

CUSTOMS ORDER

IMPORT INSTRUCTIONS FOR SPECIAL SERVICES

Information for the customer:

As part of the power of attorney conferred upon it, DHL shall disburse any duties, fees etc., on behalf of the customer, however it shall not be obliged to do so and may, at its own discretion, refuse to clear shipments through customs in a particular case if valid reasons exist. DHL shall charge a separate processing fee for special clearance services such as transit clearance. For further details, please refer to DHL Express's price brochure. No liability of any kind whatsoever shall be accepted, in particular in respect of search procedures, tax assessment notices etc. if T1 transit procedures are not completed. Invoiced amounts shall be due for payment within seven days. These instructions shall not apply to shipments that do not need to be presented to customs or can be exempted from customs clearance, taking into account the documents accompanying shipments that are available when the shipments are imported without levying import duties; these shipments shall be cleared by DHL. DHL shall act solely on the basis of the terms and conditions of carriage printed on the back of the waybill and the current version of its general terms and conditions.
