Information per goods item:

Per shipment declared for export:

(Requirement for export declaration: unchanged for goods with a value of €1,000 or more)

The Master Reference Number (MRN) can be included in the electronic transmission of shipment data for items declared for export (optional)	NEW	NEW

* Please note that, until further notice, relevant customs documents – invoice for customs purposes, export accompanying document and proof of preference, if applicable, as well as the customs declaration (CN23; for DHL Paket International shipments only) – must be attached to the outside of the parcel on each shipment.
